Inside email, docs, CRMs. Less "go to an AI app," more "AI wherever you work."

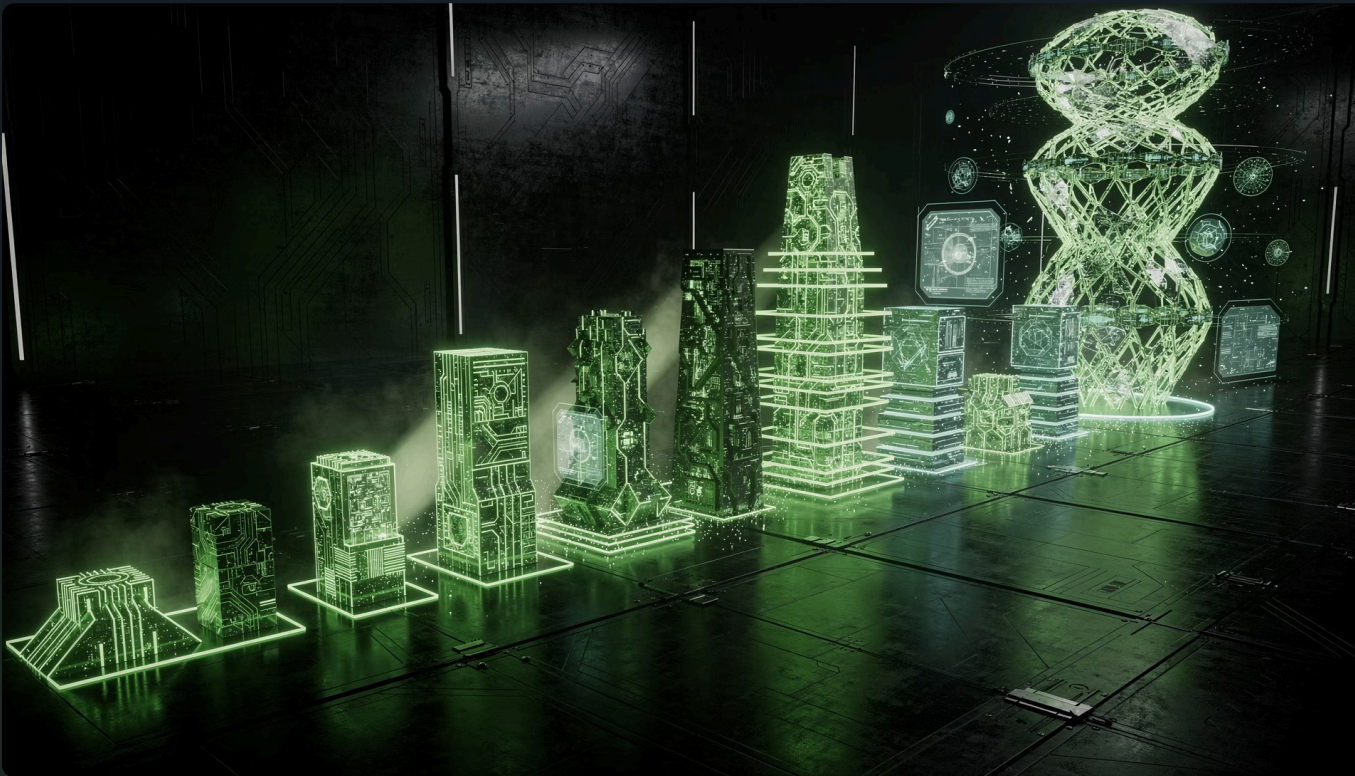

Tools You Can Use Immediately



Thinking & Writing

ChatGPT or Claude for analysis, drafting, problem-solving



Research

Perplexity for sourced insights and fact-finding



Creating Visuals

Canva AI for decks, graphics, social content



Organization

Notion AI or Google Workspace AI for docs and notes

Simple Rule

One thinking tool.

One creating tool.

One organizing tool.

📌 **No tool overload.** Start with one in each category, master it, then expand.

How to Start Without Feeling Overwhelmed



The 30-Minute Rule

Pick one recurring task. Use AI for first draft, summary, or improvement. Keep human final pass.



Simple Prompt Formula

Role + Context + Output Format + Constraints. One example. No jargon.



Start Small, Stay Consistent

Daily practice beats occasional perfection. Build the habit.



The Real Opportunity

Remember This

AI won't replace leaders.

Leaders who ignore leverage replace themselves.

The gap won't be between big and small—it'll be between adaptive and static.



You don't need to be an expert



You need to be a user



Start small. Stay consistent.
